

Update as from 29 April 2020 for SEA countries Entry & visa restrictions:

### **SEA Countries' Entry & Visa Restrictions :**

#### **CHINA & Hong Kong ( Total confirmed new cases 6↓)**

**Entry restrictions** : **Closed.** Foreign nationals are not permitted to enter China  
**Transit restrictions** : Passengers are no longer permitted to transit through Beijing Capital International Airport and Xiamen Airport.  
**Visa restrictions** : All visa free transit services have been suspended  
**Quarantine measures** : All passengers, regardless of nationality, will be subject to the latest quarantine policies

#### **HONG KONG**

**Entry restriction** : **Closed.** All Non-Hong Kong residents are not permitted to enter till further notice..  
**Transit restrictions:** Passengers are no longer permitted to transit through Hong Kong International Airport.

#### **VIETNAM (Total confirmed new cases 0)**

**Entry restriction: Closed.** All foreign nationalities are denied entry into Vietnam until 30 April 2020.  
-All flights to Ho Chi Minh City or Hanoi are suspended until 15 April 2020  
-Flights from Ho Chi Minh City or Hanoi are unaffected  
**Visa Restrictions:** Visas and visas-on-arrival will not be accepted

#### **CAMBODIA ( Total confirmed new cases 0)**

**Entry Restriction** : -All passengers who have been to, or are originating from China , France, Germany, Italy, Spain , Iran, USA are not allowed to enter or transit Cambodia.  
-The entry of passengers on ships at all waterways, including sea ways and ports until further notice is suspended till further notice  
**Medical Certificate:** All foreigners must: - have a medical certificate, issued by competent health authorities of their country no more than 72 hours prior to the date of travel, certifying that they are not tested positive for the Coronavirus (COVID - 19); and have proof of insurance policy with minimum medical coverage of 50,000\$US.  
**Visa restrictions:** All visa exemptions, visas on arrival and e-visas are suspended till 30 April 2020.  
**Quarantine** : The following passengers will be subject to 14 days of compulsory quarantine upon arrival: Nationals and residents of Cambodia Diplomats and officials of foreign embassies and international organisations and their family members who are holding the Diplomatic Visa Type A and Official Visa Type B, who live or have been in or via France, Germany, Iran, Italy, Spain or the US in the past 14 days measures

#### **LAOS ( Total confirmed new cases 0)**

**Entry Restriction:** Flights to Lao People's Dem. Rep. are suspended until 3 May 2020.  
**Visa Restriction** : Laos has stopped issuing Visa on Arrival and e-Visa for all countries effective March 20 till further notice  
**Quarantine** : All travellers arriving in Laos from a country with confirmed cases of COVID-19 will be asked to self-monitor and self-quarantine for 14 days.  
-Laos Airlines have cut off most of flights across the region

#### **MYANMAR (Total confirmed new cases 0)**

**Entry restriction** : **Closed.** All international flights are not allowed to land until 30 April 2020  
**Visa restrictions** : on arrival services and e-visas have been suspended for all nationals until 30 April 2020.

#### **SINGAPORE ( Total confirmed new cases 799↑)**

**Entry restriction** : **Closed.** from 23 March till further notice , all short-term visitors (from anywhere in the world) are not allowed entry into Singapore, or to transit through Singapore.  
-Singapore has also ceased port calls for all cruise vessels.

#### **MALAYSIA ( Total confirmed new cases 40↓)**

**Entry restriction** : **Closed.** All foreign nationals, are prohibited from entering or transiting through Malaysia till 12 May 2020

**Visa restrictions** : The Malaysian Government has suspended new visa applications (i.e. eNTRI, visa on arrival, e-visa and manual visa) for Chinese nationals and other nationalities who have visited Hubei, Zhejiang and/or Jiangsu provinces of China in the past 14 days

#### **INDONESIA ( Total confirmed new cases 214 ↓)**

**Entry restrictions:** **Closed.** An Entry ban applies to all foreigners till further notice

**Visa Restrictions:** Visa exemption policy for a short-stay visit, visa-on-arrival and diplomatic/service visa-free facilities for all countries has been suspended.

#### **PHILIPPINES ( Total confirmed new cases 198 ↓)**

**Entry restrictions:** The Philippines has shut down all travel into and out of the capital of Manila until April 14, 2020

-Philippine & Cebu Pacific Airlines to suspend all international; flights form 26 march till 14 April,2020

-Passengers who have transited through or have been in China (People's Rep.), Hong Kong (SAR China) or Macao (SAR China) in the past 14 days are not allowed to enter the Philippines. - Passengers with a Hong Kong (SAR China) passport, Macao (SAR China) passport, Macao-Portuguese, and British National Overseas passports.

**Medical Certificate:** Passengers who have transited through or have been in Iran or Italy in the past 14 days are required to present a Medical Clearance or Health Declaration Certificate, issued by Health Authority within 48 hours prior to arrival and certifying that the passenger is free from Coronavirus(COVID-19).

**Quarantine:** Passengers who have transited through or have been in Iran or Italy in the past 14 days, are required to undergo a 14-day quarantine.

**Visa restrictions:** all Embassies and Consulates will temporarily suspend visa issuance to all foreign nationals as well as the visa-free privileges of all foreign nationals,

#### **JAPAN ( Total confirmed new cases 191 ↓)**

**Entry restrictions:** - Passengers Travelling on a People's Republic of China passport that lists Hubei or Zhejiang province as the place of issue are not permitted to enter Japan

- Foreign nationals who have visited one or more of the following destinations in the past 14 days are not permitted to enter Japan : Brunei, China (including Mainland China, Hong Kong SAR and Macao SAR), Indonesia, Malaysia, Philippines, Republic of Korea (South Korea), Singapore, Taiwan, Thailand, Vietnam,Australia, New Zealand,Canada, United States of America,Bolivia, Brazil, Chile, Ecuador, Dominica, Panama ,Albania, Andorra, Armenia. Austria, Belgium, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Bulgaria, Croatia, Cyprus, Czech Republic, Denmark, Estonia, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Hungary, Iceland, Ireland, Italy, Kosovo, Latvia, Liechtenstein, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Malta, Moldova, Monaco, Montenegro, Netherlands, North Macedonia, Norway, Poland, Portugal, Romania, San Marino, Serbia, Slovakia, Slovenia, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland, the United Kingdom, Vatican, Bahrain, Israel, Iran, Turkey, Cote d'Ivoire, Democratic Republic of Congo, Egypt, Mauritius, Morocco

**Quarantine** : All passengers will be subject to 14 days of quarantine at a location designated by the quarantine station chief, and are not permitted to use public transportation.

**Visa restrictions:** Visa issuance services for Chinese nationals have been suspended until further notice. The visa waiver program for Hong Kong SAR, Macao SAR and Korean passport holders have been suspended until further notice

\*\*\*Tokyo Olympic Games rescheduled to July 23, 2021 – August 8, 2021

#### **TAIWAN ( Total confirmed new cases 2 ↓)**

**Entry restrictions:** **Closed.** Foreign nationals are not permitted to enter or to transit through Taiwan From 24 March to 30 April 2020,

#### **SOUTH KOREA ( Total confirmed new cases 14 ↓)**

**Entry restrictions:** Passengers who meet one or more of the following criteria are not permitted to enter South Korea: Travelling on a People's Republic of China passport that lists Hubei province as the place of issue, Travelling on any type of visa issued by the Korean Consulate in Wuhan, Have visited the Hubei province in the past 14 days, Nationals of Japan who do not hold a Korean visa issued on or after 9 March 2020

**Quarantine:** All passengers arriving in South Korea are required to undergo quarantine for 14 days upon entry. Foreigners with short-term visas or without a domestic residence are subject to quarantine at a government facility, at the expense of KRW1,400,000. All passengers should install the "Self-Diagnosis Mobile app" upon entering Korea.

**Visa restrictions:** Visa waiver programme for Indonesian passport holders and passengers travelling to Jeju (CJU) on a People's Republic of China passport has been suspended

**SRI LANKA (Total confirmed new cases 0)**

**Entry restrictions:** **Closed.** All airports in Sri Lanka are closed until further notice.

**NEPAL (Total confirmed new cases 1 ↑)**

**Entry restrictions:** **Closed.** All flights to Nepal have been suspended until 27 April 2020.  
All trekking permits issue suspended till 30 April 2020

**BHUTAN (Total confirmed new cases 0)**

**Entry restrictions:** Bhutan is **closed** for tourism until further notice.
